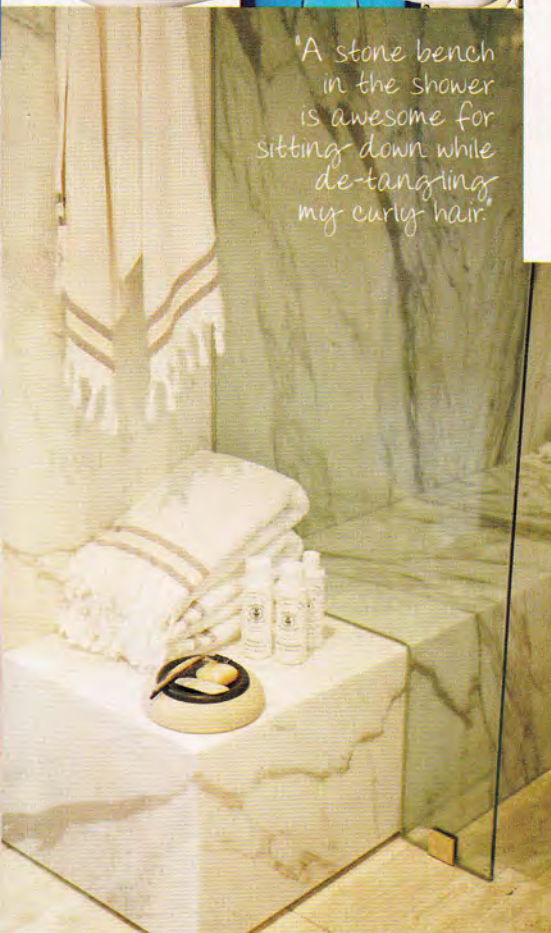




"A stone bench in the shower is awesome for sitting down while de-tangling my curly hair."
